OPENING WORDS
The Hawaiian word for love is aloha and today we've come together to celebrate the special aloha that exists

Both hold on to the paddle while leis are draped over them. Michaela explains the Hawaiian Blessing and circles the couple with sacred water to prepare them for their journey.
LEI EXCHANGE (Optional)
Words are shared about the sacred ceremony of Marriage, the Couple exchanges leis.
THE VOWS – Repeat after me or prepare your vows. **These vows will be removed when couples prepare
their vows.

I promise to bring the best of me to our lives and our marriage.
To share my thoughts and feelings.
Laugh with you and cry with you.
Encourage and inspire you.
